

# Creative Life Scrapbooking February 2018 Sketch

This sketch is designed to fit many pictures into a 2-page spread with a few embellishments, but if you prefer more white space or room for journaling and decorations, you can certainly remove some of the photos.

Photo sizes:

- 5x7 (1 photo)
- 5x4 (2 photos)
- 4x3 (3 photos)
- 6x4 (2 photos)

## Supplies:

- 2 album pages or pieces of base cardstock
- 2 sheets of decorative paper
- Embellishments
- Large trimmer
- Border punch or border maker

## Directions:

1. Punch or cut 4 12-inch border strips from one sheet of decorative paper.
2. Cut two photo mats from another sheet of decorative paper: 5.5x7.5 and 6.5x8.75
3. Mat the 5x7 photo with the 5.5x7.5 mat. Adhere the matted photo to the left page.
4. Adhere the 6.5x8.75 mat to the right page.
5. Attach the four border strips to the pages, one about 1 inch from the top of each page and one about 2 inches from the bottom of each page.
6. Adhere the remaining photos to the page as shown.
7. Add a title, journaling, and embellishments.
