## Creative Life Scrapbooking February 2018 Sketch

This sketch is designed to fit many pictures into a 2-page spread with a few embellishments, but if you prefer more white space or room for journaling and decorations, you can certainly remove some of the photos. Photo sizes:

- $5 \times 7$ (1 photo)
- $5 \times 4$ (2 photos)
- $4 \times 3$ (3 photos)
- 6x4 (2 photos)


## Supplies:

- 2 album pages or pieces of base cardstock
- 2 sheets of decorative paper
- Embellishments
- Large trimmer
- Border punch or border maker


## Directions:

1. Punch or cut 412 -inch border strips from one sheet of decorative paper.
2. Cut two photo mats from another sheet of decorative paper: $5.5 \times 7.5$ and 6.5x8.75
3. Mat the $5 \times 7$ photo with the $5.5 \times 7.5$ mat. Adhere the matted photo to the left page.
4. Adhere the $6.5 \times 8.75$ mat to the right page.
5. Attach the four border strips to the pages, one about 1 inch from the top of each page and one about 2 inches from the bottom of each page.
6. Adhere the remaining photos to the page as shown.
7. Add a title, journaling, and embellishments.
