

Creative Life Scrapbooking September 2019 Sketch

This sketch is designed to fit 6 4"x6" photos in a 2-page spread with a few embellishments and a small amount of journaling. There is room to move things around and include more or larger photos. If you have more journaling for the page, consider replacing one of the photos with a journal mat so you have more space to tell the story.

Besides your photos, the “star” of this layout is the pieced background—a perfect way to use strips of paper from your scrap stash and to incorporate different colors and patterns that might not always be put together.

Supplies:

- 2 album pages or pieces of base cardstock
- 3 or more sheets of decorative paper (or the equivalent in 1" strips)
- Embellishments
- Large trimmer
- Border punch or border maker

Directions:

1. Cut 24 10"x1" strips from decorative paper. Arrange these across the center of both pages and adhere to the pages.
2. Adhere photos to both pages.
3. Punch borders and attach them to both pages.
4. Add a title, journaling, and embellishments.
